Suspect: White Male adult, early 20's, 6'0" to 6'1", brown eyes, brown hair, freckles, very short hair like a crew cut, with pale skin. Wearing glasses, faded navy baseball cap, grey t-shirt and baggy grass green basketball like shorts with stripe down the legs.



Incident(s): Victim was walking toward the Rec Pool between the lodge and the pool. Victim noticed a male with his pants down and his penis exposed. Suspect fled into parking lot 30 at which time victim lost site of him among the vehicles.
