Campus Crime Alert Bulletin

Crimes: 664/211 PC – Attempted Robbery
242 PC - Battery

Dates: November 15, 2008 and November 20, 2008

Times: 10:18 PM and 9:20 PM

Location 1: Bike Tunnel, 945 W Olive Drive, Davis
Location 2: East side of A Street between Second and Third

Davis P.D. Case #'s: 08-06055 and 08-6142

Suspects: Three black male adults wearing all black, with black hoodies over their heads. All are approximately 5'11". Two of the males were trim build, one heavysset. One suspect had ¼ mustache. Unknown ages.

Incident 1: Victim was punched in the face and suffered injuries after being stopped by three suspects on a bike path. Suspects also took property and fled the scene.

Incident 2: Victims were a male graduate student and a female companion. Victims were walking northbound on A Street, on the east sidewalk. Three black males wearing hoodies approached and walked past the victims without saying anything. After passing the victims, one suspect grabbed the female victim from behind and began to drag her towards the shadows. Suspect attempted to remove victim's shoulder purse. Another suspect used his fist to hit the male victim in the right eye. Female victim screamed and the suspects ran off southbound on A Street. No property was stolen.

Note: This is possibly the third in a series of similar strong arm robberies that have occurred in Davis over the past two weeks involving the same suspects.
